Calendars- After much discussion, mainly over how to ensure payment of the calendars and/or the return of them in a timely manner, and the low profit margin, Jeni motions to nix the sale of calendars. Tina 2nds. All in favor.

Spirit Night- Because Camden Gymnastics is not a school or church, we are unable to have a Spirit night at this time.

Ops~ We have a Spirit Night scheduled for Wednesday January 18th from 5p-8p. 10% of all sales will go to the Booster Club if mentioned to the Cashier. This is for dine in and carry out. Charon will make a flier to post. Jeni motions to make this a monthly fundraiser, Mary Lee 2nds. All in favor.

Fundraiser Minimums~ Census is that there is not a problem with support in doing the fundraisers. Many said that if there were minimums imposed that they would be less likely to do a fundraiser. Mary Lee motions to deny minimums, Jeni seconds. All in favor.

Christmas Party:

Change of location~ The Rec Center closes at 6p on Saturdays now. Coach Angela has private lessons going until 5p on every Saturday. Yuri wants to be asked ahead of time about doing parties in the gym and coaches need to be asked to volunteer their time at the gym instead of being voluntold to come. Because of the Rec Center not being an option at this time, the following were looked into:

Bowling- Strike Zone in Brunswick- Saturday is \$4 per game plus shoes at \$3.50 per person. Group rate is only available if we have at least 20 people participating. It includes 2 games of bowling plus shoes for \$8. Denny's is on site so we can order food individually. There is a \$50 deposit that is non refundable and will go towards our total for bowling. Outside food is not allowed.

Skating- Skate World in Kingsland- Saturday night from 7p-10p \$3 includes skates. 3 hours in the party room. Can still bring cake (and all necessities to go with it) Can still do gift exchange (just need to designate someone to stay near to ensure none of our stuff walks off. We can still do simple crafts.

Patrice tells about bowling on base. Discussion about base access and lane availability is an issue. Joy motions to go skating. There is no 2nd. Jeni motions to have an end of season party in May, Pam 2nds. No gift exchange or crafts because that was to go with the party.

From Yuri: Nationals & Flip Fest Not counting on going to Nationals in Wisconsin. Looking at 4k to 5k in coaches fees. INSTEAD we can do flip fest together! Cost is around \$700 per gymnast (possible discount on siblings, less cost for bringing a friend who doesn't do gymnastics) Payments can be made. Yuri said if we have 10 gymnasts we can rent a van/bus for the trip for a minimal cost to parents. This is a 1 week camp with Olympians. Only 190 kids allowed per week. 13 beds per cabin plus adult counselor. Looking at last week of May, June or July. (Yuri's decision if going by group) Other things available to do (tubing, fishing, crafts, charity work..)
